Novoform Is a lightweight and durable encapsulated wire framework offered as an alternative to traditional timber or blockwork formwork. Manufactured using 4mm cross wires at 150mm centres on 3mm line wires at 75mm centres. Designed, tested and proven to suit foundations containing reinforcement of various depths.



Material	Steel mesh encapsulated with 2 layers of heat-shrunk polyethylene
